Kathleen’s Story

For years I stood against God. Always claiming that “I didn’t believe”, or “there’s no such thing”. But my heart always told me different. I blamed my problems on God. A year and a half ago that all changed. I was blessed with a beautiful baby boy. He was a sick baby, he had breathing problems, he seemed to have infections, and something was just off about him. We brought him to doctors countless times only to be sent home, calm and at ease that our baby was fine. Our son had a fall off a couch and that is when our life completely changed forever. We brought him to the doctor twice after his fall only to be told he was fine the first visit. The second visit we were told our son had a fractured rib. A few hours later there were police and a social worker there to apprehend our son. I had a stranger rip my four week old baby from my arms. From there it was weeks before we even saw our son. We were treated like monsters. Blamed for the injuries my son had. People rounding up his injuries to make our case and to get what they wanted, to have our baby adopted.

I turned to God. But I needed proof. I was falling fast and I so desperately needed a sign. I was at a book reading where a lady was speaking and giving messages to the people in the audience. I asked God, that if he was real that he speak through her to me. At the end she stopped what she was saying to pick me out of the audience and the first thing she said to me is “God is real you know”. That did it for me. She gave me a promise that I was to be given back what was stolen, that God wanted vindication for my situation. This is a lady who knew nothing of my story. God led me to where I am now. He led me to all the people who helped us in our case. We were led to doctors who disagreed with CAS, we were led to advocates, and we were led to our lawyer. We fought for 15 months. Five days into the trial they folded. The very people, who told us we would NEVER get our son back, never have a family again. They were so sure. But we pushed back with God at our side. On November 27, 2012 we were told to go and get our son. I can’t even put into words what this situation has done to me, not only has it been damaging, it has also led me to God. To now live at ease knowing that there is always a purpose and always someone looking over me.
