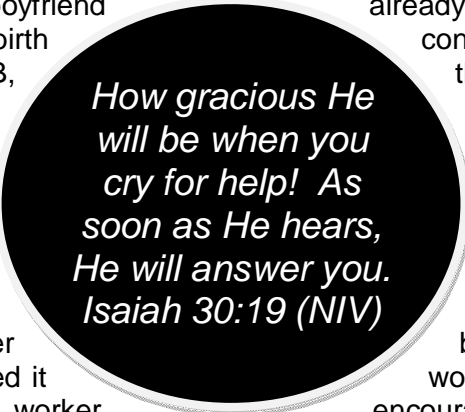

On August 6, 2013 a healthy baby girl weighing 7 pounds 2 ounces. **We prayed a prayer of praise.**

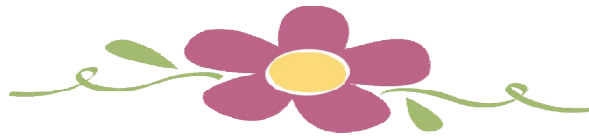


2013 Statistics

1,333 clients visited the Centre, up **228** from last year
112 of those visits were new client cases
112 client visits is the monthly average
52 of our clients were pregnant
29 pregnancy tests were done; 6 positive, 23 negative
23 negative test clients were given abstinence advice and STI information
36 babies were born
375 times clients came for prenatal education, parenting education or group classes, up **133** from last year
5,855 items of clothing, diapers, formula and other material items were given to clients, up **2,388** from last year
214 clients in total, 191 female, 23 male

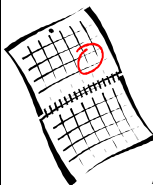
